Lyme Disease - from deer ticks

- Symptoms: aches, fevers and fatigue
- Look for: expanding, bull's-eye rash
- Typcially: rash appears 2-40 days after bite...
- As the rash grows, the origin fades leaving a ring that resembles a bull's-eye.
- If rash present/ tick bite presumed, antibiotic treatment recommended.
- Rash develops in only 80% of cases.
- Untreated: can lead to arthritis, facial paralysis, meningitis, memory loss and mood changes.

Weils Desease

- Symptoms: flu-like illness, severe headaches and meningitis jaundice, meningitis, conjunctivitis and kidney failure.
- Untreated can lead to death.
- If you develop flu like symptoms 3-19 days after contact with contaminated water then you should contact a doctor, explain the circumstances and ask for the Elisa blood test

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
